Participants will be trained in the use of various imaging techniques particularly CT scan for diagnosis and treatment planning of implant cases. They will be taught to use a very comprehensive implant patient's record system so that nothing would be missed out in the various phases of implant treatment. They will also be taught how to fabricate surgical guide for accurate control of the planned drilling positions and directions at the time of implant surgery thus ensuring maximal safety and accuracy in implant placement surgery.

Bone augmentation is an inseparable part of the clinical practice of oral implantology. It is not uncommon to see cases that need implant treatment but there is not enough bone. Oral implants need good bone both in quantity and quality for their initial placement and perpetuation during function.

This course will elaborate on the scientific basis and the surgical techniques of guided bone regeneration, the various bone grafting materials and membranes.

The participants will perform the exercise of application of bone grafting materials and the membranes on teaching models.
