Bone augmentation is an inseparable part of the clinical practice of oral implantology. It is not uncommon to see cases that need implant treatment but there is not enough bone. Oral implants need good bone both in quantity and quality for their initial placement and perpetuation during function.

This course will elaborate on the scientific basis and the surgical techniques of guided bone regeneration, the various bone grafting materials and membranes. The participants will perform the exercise of application of bone grafting materials and membranes on teaching models.

Implant dentistry has been promoted to be very easy and even novices are performing advanced procedures beyond their competence through the efforts of the commercial sector. In reality, only a small percentage of the clinical cases are that easy. The majority of them are rather tricky in the way that many inexperienced clinicians fall into the trap of under evaluation in the treatment planning phase which leads to disastrous outcome of implant treatment. In this workshop, the participants will go through the exercise of handling a variety of difficult clinical cases through the various treatment phases – from diagnosis and treatment planning to the final outcome.
